Bitcoin is an electronic-digital cryptographic currency based on a data-structure called Blockchain.

In its turn, the Blockchain is a decentralized and secured digital ledger, which records and keeps transactions. This is a new form of payment and more and more retailers begin to accept this currency since the technology (Blockchain) was accepted in 2008 and the Bitcoin payment system was released as the open source software in the year 2009.

On July 19th, 2017, MoMath offered the Bitcoin: A Little "Bit" of Math

Event with the following agenda: "All money is a mathematical abstraction, but cryptocurrencies like Bitcoin especially depend on a lot of deep mathematics for their existence. In this in-depth class, you'll learn how some obscure branches of mathematics came together to become a \$30 billion economic system; you'll understand the inner workings of Bitcoin and the blockchain on which it is based; and you'll even learn how to steal Bitcoin with math. No mathematical background is required, however, the class is best suited to an adult audience" (<https://in.momath.org/civCRM/event/info?reset=1&id=1088>).

According to Lisa Sherman-Cohen, PR associate for the National Museum of Mathematics (MoMath), "the event is at capacity" and was SOLD OUT at the \$60 ticket price.
